Holidays (December 24, 25, 31; January 1): Although City Park administration offices are closed on federal and state holidays, the dog park will remain open for your use during its regular operational hours.

Be advised, however, that maintenance will also have limited hours. It might be a good idea to bring a poop bag or two from home incase the poop stations do not get refilled as needed. Extra liner bags are tied at each station incase the liner bag becomes full. Your help is needed during this limited maintenance time: you may remove the full bag and put in the extra bag if needed.

PERMIT SALES: New permits and renewals are on sale now at the dog park office. **If you are a renewal, you may just print out the form from our website www.nolacitybark.org and mail it with your check payable to City Park/dog park or credit card information to #1 Palm Dr. NOLA 70124.** Your existing card will be reactivated.

New permit applications may also be mailed in, but the cards must be picked up at the dog park office between 9am and 5pm, Monday-Friday. If you want a card mailed, please include \$5 extra for mailing.
