You are receiving this newsletter because our records show that you have not renewed your dog park permit and your security card will be deactivated this week. If you think there has been an error please contact the office by email at info@nolacitybark.org.

Office: 1 Palm Drive
Directions: enter off Marconi on Roosevelt Mall. You will see a new building on your left. At the traffic circle, make a 3/4 turn to enter Palm Dr. We are next to the railroad tracks.

LAST CHANCE!

1. All 2010 permits that have not been renewed will be deactivated beginning today, February 2, 2011.
2. If you purchased your permit between **August 1 and October 31**, your permit fee is \$25 for 2011 as we realize that there was some confusion with the renewal date. If you purchased after November 1, your permit is good until Dec. 2011.
3. New permits and permit renewals are still only \$35 and are valid through December 31, 2011.
4. **You do not need to come to the office to renew your permit.** Download the form from the website, fill it out and mail in with your payment.
5. Permits may also be renewed by bringing the permit form to our office at #1 Palm Drive, NOLA 70124. (see directions on left)
Office hours are: 8AM-5PM, M - F.
6. **We accept cash, check or credit cards.**
7. You will keep your existing 2010 entry card and it will be activated for 2011 upon renewal.
8. After January 31, please do not admit persons into the park who show a card that does not activate the gate release. Remind them that they need to send in a renewal form and pay the \$35 fee for 2011.
